The Department of Psychology invites applications from individuals interested in teaching **PSYC 6633 Psychopharmacology** in the fall semester, 2024.

Course Title: PSYC 6633 Psychopharmacology

Course Schedule: Will be determined by the PsyD Program Director in consultation with the instructor.

Campus Location: St. John's Campus, In Person

Course Description: This course will cover the epidemiology, clinical course, etiology, and pathophysiology of the disorder and will provide an evidence-based approach to treatment for a variety of disorders that a Doctor of Psychology (PsyD) practitioner is likely to encounter in practice. Topic areas and disease states that will be covered include psycho-pharmacotherapy general concepts and special populations, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, major depressive disorder, anxiety disorders, insomnia, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, dementia - Alzheimer's disease, eating disorders and substance use disorders.
