Course Title: PSYC 7020 Practicum in Adult Assessment and Diagnosis I

Course Schedule: Will be determined by the PsyD Program Director in consultation with the instructor.

Campus Location: St. John's Campus, In Person

Course Description: This course introduces adult psychometric assessment and diagnosis. Students develop skills in clinical interviewing and competence in the administration and interpretation of selected instruments. The course includes consideration of standards, ethics, uses, and interpretations of selected measures with consideration for diverse populations and individual difference factors. The course will consist of lectures, discussions, demonstration, and observation. Students will develop interviewing skills using a standardized patient and are expected to perform one interview and assessment as well as observe the interviews and assessments of their classmates and provide feedback. During the latter part of the course, students will be required to conduct a comprehensive assessment using a previously collected assessment data and integrate these findings into a final report. Qualifications: (1) A doctorate (PhD or PsyD) from a CPA- or APA-accredited clinical psychology program, (2) successful completion of a CPA- or APA- accredited pre-doctoral internship in clinical psychology, (3) either registered or provisionally registered with the Newfoundland and Labrador Psychology Board, (4) demonstrated knowledge of the specific topics noted in the course description above, including proficiency in the administration and scoring of the WAIS and PAI, and (5) documented clinical experience conducting assessment with adults.
